

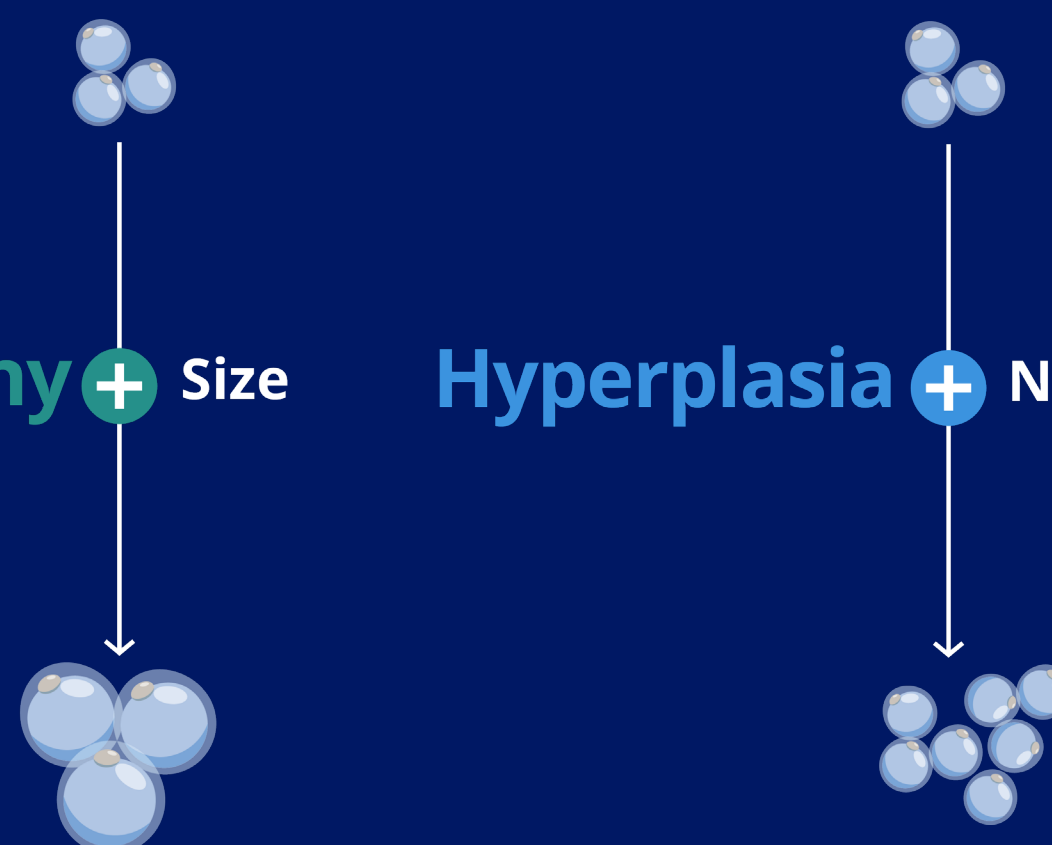
The role of *inflammation* in obesity

Adipose tissue is **dysregulated** in people with **obesity**

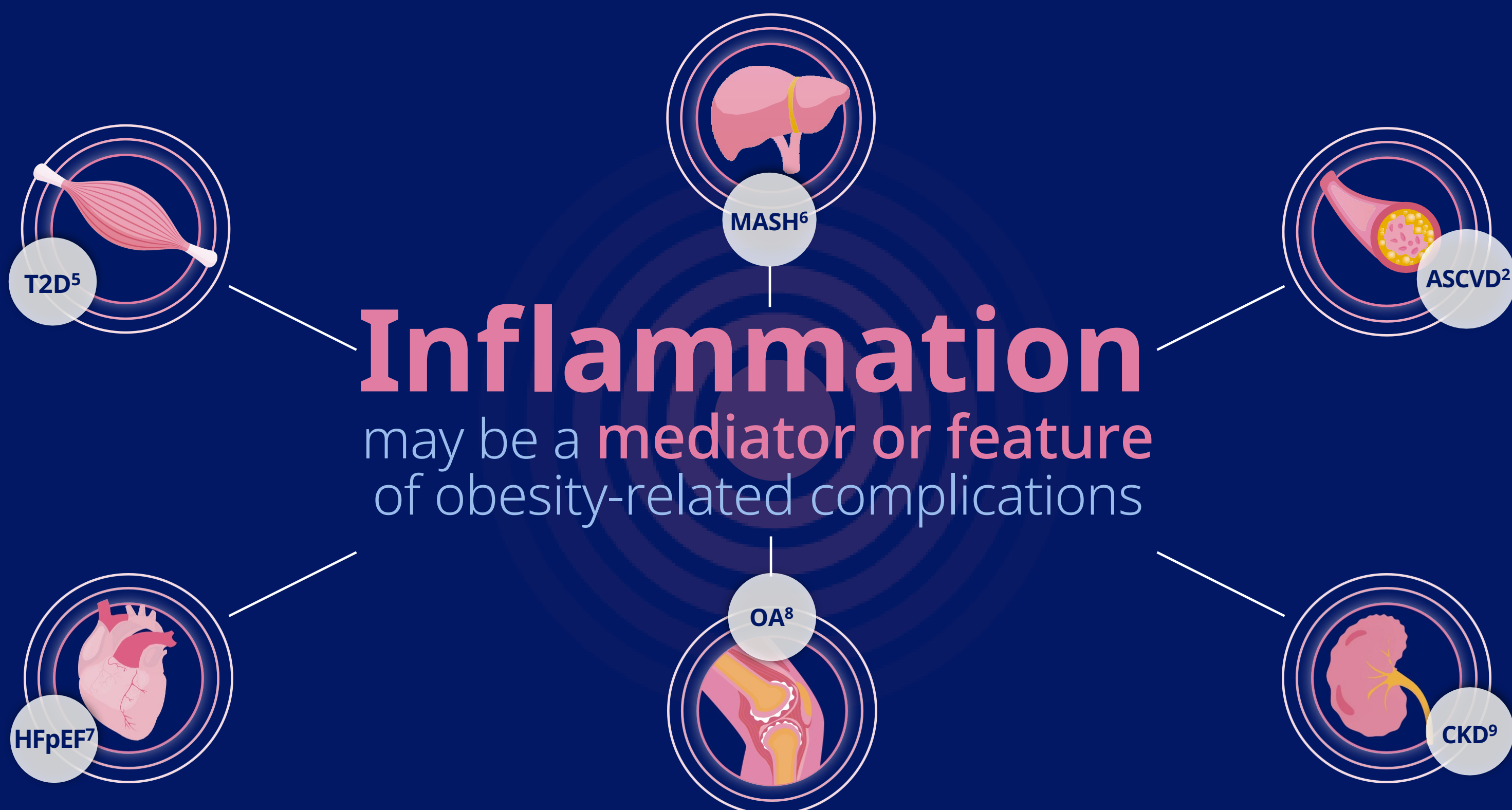
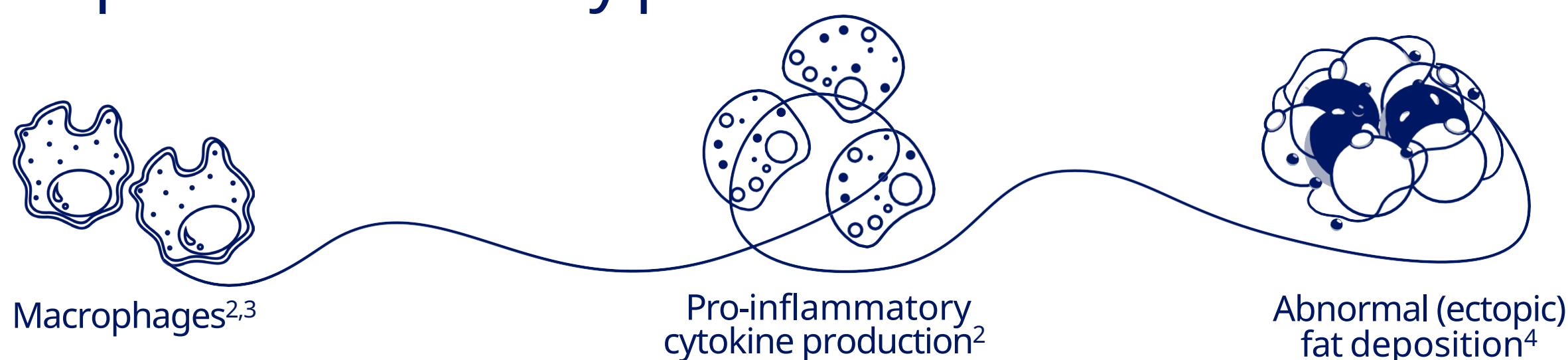
This is illustrated by **hypertrophy** (increased size) and **hyperplasia** (increased number) of adipocytes, the body's main energy-storing cells^{1,2}
